HEAL of Washington County, a non-profit organization that promotes Healthy Eating and Active Lifestyles to help reduce the effects of obesity will be hosting one of their 10,000 steps programs here in Williamsport this Spring! The kick off for this event will be held on Tuesday, April 14th at 5:00pm. Anyone interested in participating in this free program should meet at Pavilion #1 (that sits behind the library) in Byron Memorial Park.

This program is an 8 week structured walking program that is free and open to everyone! HEAL offers free pedometers to any registrants who would like to make use of one. Participants can attend the weekly meetings to walk for approximately an hour and to learn about different topics in fitness and wellness. Each weekly session will cover a different topic and they will be led by fitness leaders who can offer valuable advice and tips related to each topic. Participants will be asked to keep track of the steps/distance they walk each day and will work with the fitness leaders to set reasonable and attainable goals from week to week. HEAL of Washington County has hosted this same program in Hagerstown and is now working with the Williamsport Wellness team to expand their efforts to the Town of Williamsport.
