

**TOWN OF WILLIAMSPORT
MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
March 14, 2011**

A regular meeting of the Williamsport Mayor and Council was held on March 14, 2011, at the Williamsport Town Hall in Williamsport, MD at 7:00 p.m.

A motion was made by Councilman Tim Fraker to accept the minutes of the regular meeting held February 14, 2011 and the Public Hearing for Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment and Property No Longer Needed (American Legion) held on March 8, 2011 and the Special Meeting to adopt the text Amendment and Vote on Property No Longer Needed for Public Use. Financial Report

Mike Sparks, Director of Economic Development and Community Relations for the Town of Williamsport reported on the following.

*The Town of Williamsport received a grant from CDBG in the amount of \$40,120.00. This will be used for ADA improvements to Town Hall to make it ADA compliant.

*He also reported that the town received a \$325,000 grant from ARC this money will be used towards the rehabilitation of the town's four pump stations.

*The sign at the canal has been installed; it has a canal map and a business directory.

*He has received bicycle signs to mark the bike paths in Williamsport.

*The Town received a \$30,000 grant from SHA for a bike and walking path in Byron Memorial Park and this project will be moving forward.

*He also reported he plans of greening the town center with the Boy and Girls Scouts.

*He reported that the new website should launch in May and there are already over 1000 people who are friends of Williamsport on Facebook.

*He has been working with Kim Waggoner to set up new track measures for town events.
