MAYOR AND COUNCIL MINUTES

February 2, 2009

A Workshop meeting of the Williamsport Mayor and Council was held on February 2, 2009, at the Williamsport Town Hall in Williamsport, MD at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor James G McCleaf II introduced Jeff Gola from Thrasher Engineering. Mr. Gola reviewed the recent bid openings for the L. Beard Miller Pool Stabilization Project. They were as follows: Milton Stamper Builders - \$56,900.00, Oliver Homes Inc - \$57,291.00, Huntzberry Brothers - \$62,225.00, R.A. Hill - \$70,800.00, Royal Construction Co. Inc - \$74,550.00, Eastern Waterproofing and Restor Co. Inc – 99,119.00 and MK Concrete Construction - \$112,132.00. Mr. Gola recommended that the Town of Williamsport award the project to Milton Stamper Builders. The bid they submitted was \$ 56,900.00.

Mayor James G McCleaf II introduced Mr. Ron Hebb. He explained to the Mayor and Council that he is requesting the use of the Community Building in Byron Memorial Park for Martial Art Classes. Councilman Drury stated that he has shown Mr. Hebb the Community Building and discussed some options for the possible use of this building. Middle School students, High School students, and also adults from the area would be attending the classes. Mr. Hebb was asked if he had a current insurance provider and he informed the Mayor and Council that he did.

Unfinished Business

Mayor James G. McCleaf II held discussion on new dates for the carnival that is to be held in Byron Memorial Park in 2009. The new dates for the carnival are June 15th – 20th, 2009. Councilman Cline held discussion on what the Town should charge the Carnival and on also who should sign the contract.

Mayor McCleaf informed the Council that Thrasher Engineering will hold the meeting for the opening of the re-bids for the MDE Sewer Project on March 3, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. at the Town Hall of Williamsport.

New Business

Mayor James G. McCleaf held discussion on Rehoboth Church requesting permission to hold a street fair on W. Salisbury St. in Williamsport on May 30, 3009.

Mayor James G. McCleaf held discussion on Boy Scout Troop #184 from Monroeville, Pa. They are requesting permission to camp in Byron Memorial Park for one night on June 22, 2009.

A motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Kalbfleisch, seconded by Councilman Drury, with all voting in favor, motion carried.
