**Bulk Pickup will be 1st Friday of each month only
(May 6) - Set out with your regular household
garbage on Thursday night - will NOT take -
metal, oil, paint, tires and batteries.**

**Brush & Metal Pickup will be done on the 2nd
Friday of each month. The cost is \$15 a backhoe
scoop. You *must* pay at Town Hall before the
pickup date. Brush must be bagged or bundled.**

Did you know? When you recycle 10 cans per week you save enough energy for 30 hours of TV watching per week! Recycle 4 Sunday newspapers per month and save 4 trees per year! Recycle 15 plastic bottles per week and save enough fiber to make 156 T-shirts per year. Recycle 1 glass bottle save enough energy to light a 100 watt lightbulb for 4 hours, or power a computer for 30 minutes or a TV for 20 minutes.
